Speed Ferries

Dover to Boulogne

Probably the cheapest of all the ferry companies. Sails 5 times a day and fares start from around £90 depending on the time of day and day of the week. A comfortable 6 hour drive from Boulogne to the house.

Dover to Calais

Sails hourly and fares start from around £70 depending on the time of day and day of the week. A comfortable 6-8-hour drive from Calais to the house.

Brittany Ferries

Portsmouth to Caen

There are 4 sailings a day and the crossing takes about 4 hours. The high season fares are from around £500 depending on the time of day and day of the week. A comfortable 3-4 hour drive from Caen to the house.

Brittany Ferries

Portsmouth to Cherbourg

There are 2 sailings per day and the crossing takes 4 hours. The high season fares are from around £500 depending on the time of day and day of the week. The drive from Cherbourg to the house is around 3-4 hours but please be warned that the road is not very good, being single carriageway with slow moving traffic for most of the way until Averanches or until you reach the E401 / A84 depending on which way you prefer.

Poole to Cherbourg

There are 3 sailing a day and the crossing time is 2 hours. The high season fare starts from around £500. The driven route is the same as above.

Brittany Ferries

Portsmouth to St Malo

The ferry leaves Portsmouth at 20:30hrs and arrives in St Malo at 08:15hrs, with the return journey leaving St Malo at 10:40hrs and arriving in Portsmouth at 18:30hrs. The high season fares start around £500. A very attractive 1.5 hour drive from St Malo to the house mainly on country roads passing through some lovely villages.

LD Line Ferries

Portsmouth to Le Havre

There is just a single sailing a day leaving Portsmouth at 23:00hrs and arriving at 07:30hrs. Return journey leaves Le Havre at 17:00hrs and arrives back at Portsmouth at 21:30hrs. The high season fare is £566 if you have a cabin overnight. A comfortable 4-5 hour drive from Le Havre to the house.
